In CSv2.04 use 320 for the combination 305+(265 or 275), and use 330 for the combination 305+(270 or 280). Using 305, 320 or 330 results in the same derived values, so it is not necessary to review and recode any cases that have already been completed. 7/2/12	616
Lung	Extra Table	An error was found affecting cases collected under CSv1 with CS Extension where code 250 was converted to 680 in CSv02.04. This error occurs for Summary Stage 2000 when SSF 1 is 988. For cases coded in CSv1, SSF 1 is 988 if the case has not been updated to CSv2 codes. Two options for cases deriving an ERROR: 1. Leave the case with the derived stage as ERROR. This will automatically be corrected with the next release of CS in 2014. 2. Change SSF 1 to 999. You will also need to change SSF 2 to 999 if you report to CoC or SEER.
